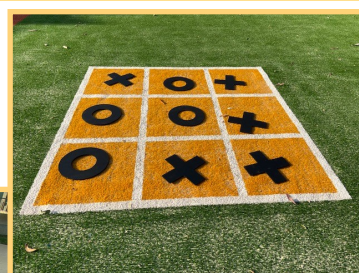

ESL LEARNING

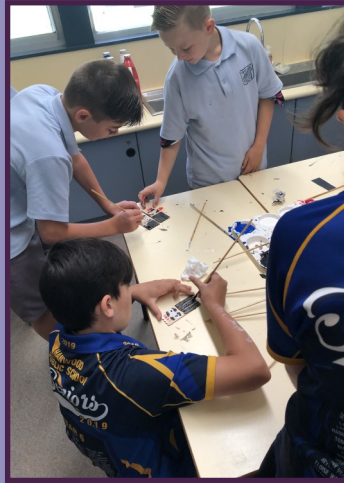
Some children in our school, who have recently arrived from overseas, are involved in our English as a Second Language (ESL) program.
