HPS Cross-Country

Our school cross-country will be held at the Hanwood Oval on **Tuesday 4 April**.

The format this year will be the same as previous years, with classes walking to the oval at different times to compete.

Students will need a bottle of water, a hat and sunscreen for the day. They will not need to take their bags to the oval.

Please remember that students can walk part of the course if they cannot run the distance. They can also drop out after 1 lap if they need to. If they choose to drop out, they will still receive a house point for participation, but will be recorded as Did Not Finish and 8-13yrs will not be eligible to attend the PSSA Zone crosscountry.

The approximate schedule will be as follows:

Please remember that students are NOT to go home after the cross-country. All students are to return to school to complete the rest of their school day.


