


EXCITEMENT IS BUILDING! 1 WEEK TO GO UNTIL OUR CONCERT!




3/4D Class News






Sentral Parent Portal


Home – This is where you will find all of the main features of the Parent Portal (newsfeed, absences, calendar, interviews).




Newsfeed – This is where you will find any notifications and reminders about school events and activities that are coming up.
