DR KATE BRICKNELL VISITS HPS

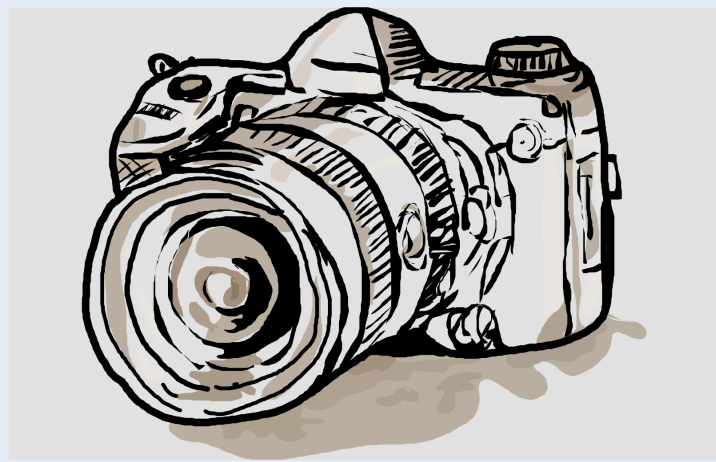
