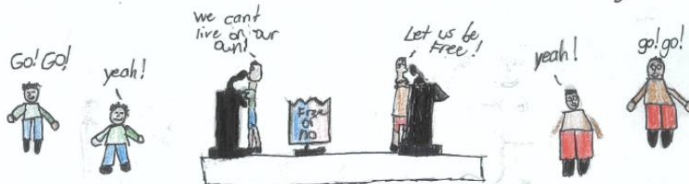
# 5/6M CLASS NEWS

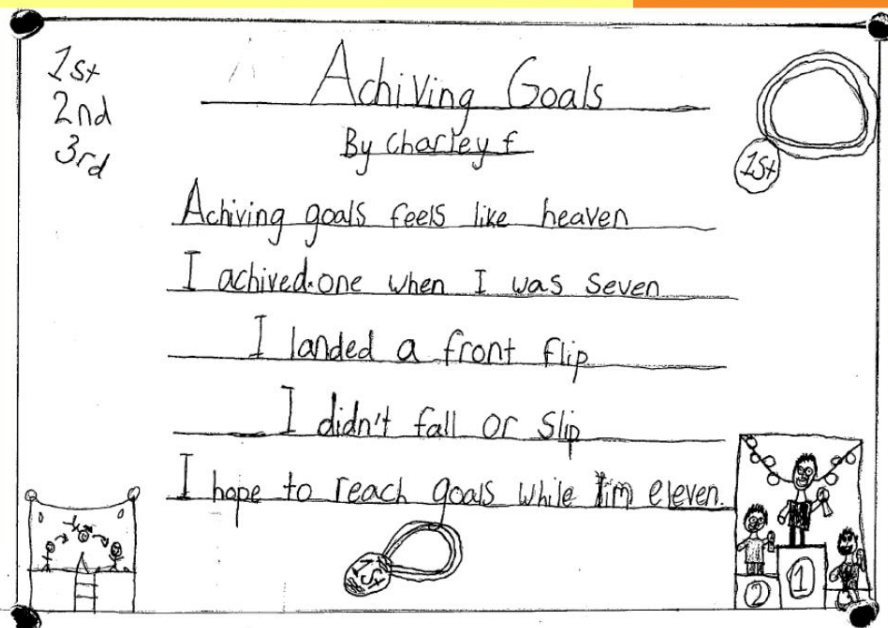
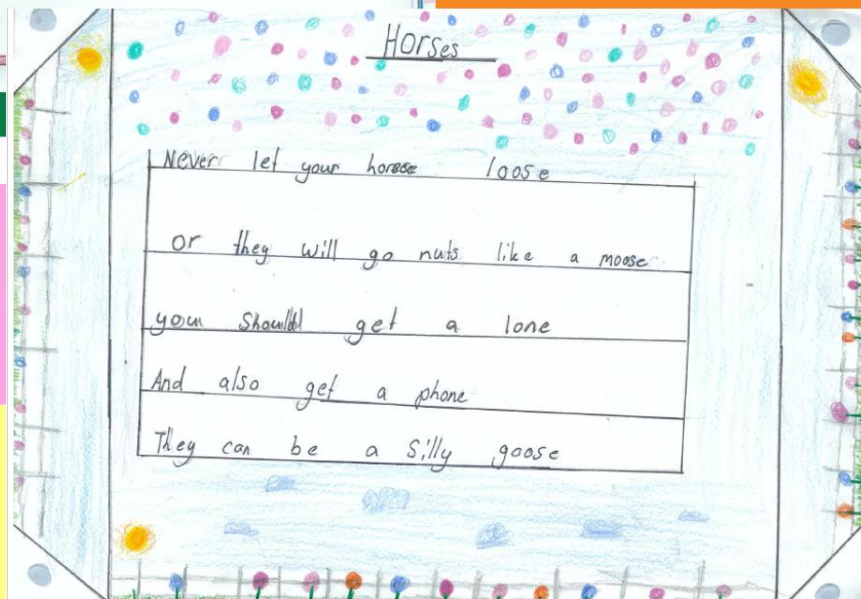
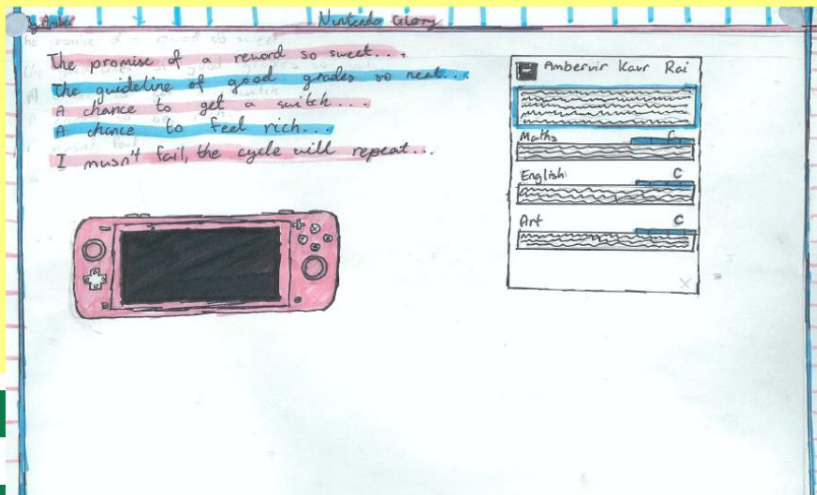
### Brightness
